Marie Bedard studied music therapy, voice, and piano at the Music Conservatory at the University of the Pacific in Stockton. She studied voice under Brenda Grimaldi and Jacquie Victorino. She was a member of the Amador Choraliers and a founding member of the female vocal ensemble “Mimosa” and belonged for 20 years. She has also been a soloist for the Motherlode Friends of Music. She performed the role of Queen of the Night in Mozart’s opera “The Magic Flute” and performed as a Leibeslieder singer in Stephen Sondheim’s “A Little Night Music”, both at California State University Sacramento.

Marie will be performing with The Motherlode Friends of Music on Sunday April 6th-2014 at 2p.m. at Sutter Creek Church of the Nazarene. Marie currently serves on the board of the Amador Student Music Fund. She has owned and operated More Than Just Hair Salon in Sutter Creek for 33 years.



Lisa Westermann, originally from Birmingham, Alabama, was a vocal scholarship recipient to the University of Montevallo and eventually the University of Alabama, Birmingham, where she studied musical theatre and English Literature. In a short-lived T.V. and Radio career, she left her station of WAPI-FM 95 in Birmingham, to study at the Conservatory and Schools for the Arts (CASA) in St. Louis, Missouri. She sang with the Symphony Chorus and was cast in the 20th Anniversary Show of "Hair" with Frankie Ford. When the show closed after a short run in the mid-west, she raveled to Europe where she auditioned for the Berlin Oper Company before coming back to the States to take up residence in San Francisco. There, she was a physical trainer and a solo concert artist out of such landmarks as St. Mary's Cathedral, bringing the traditional sacred genre back to the recital community. Ever since she's lived in Calaveras County, she has been orchestrating events like MESSIAH Sing-Alongs, stating they are the most blessed undertakings of her year's work. She is currently the Choir Director of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Jackson (the old court house) and she also plays the organ.



Bill McKenna grew up just outside of New York City, which provided him with lots of exposure to the arts. In fact, in his late teens he participated in several operas and actually sang at the old Metropolitan Opera house. (Actually he was a supernumerary-a spear carrier- and hummed along on stage during the triumphant entry of AIDA).

Bill took up singing again in earnest around 1998 when he started taking lessons from Brenda Grimaldi and then Jacquie Victorino. He does a lot of singing locally, both concerts and recitals, in and around the Jackson/Sutter Creek area where he lives and has been a featured soloist with The Mother Lode Friends of Music. He has also performed with the Bel Canto Vocal Arts Society, The Shoe String Opera and the Gold Country Orchestra all in Sacramento. Bill works in real estate in the Amador/El Dorado/Calaveras areas where he is known as the “The Singing Realtor”



Dennis Brown, baritone soloist, has been a music educator, choral director, professional accompanist in the central valley, foothills and the bay area. Most recently, Dennis, was the musical director for Sierra Repertory Theatre’s production of Church Basement Ladies. He has musically directed many times for this theatre company and many others in the previously mentioned areas in California. He has been featured as an actor/singing actor in many productions. Driving Miss Daisy, Fences, Cats, The Little Shop of Horrors, Pirates of Penzance, HMS Pinafore, Ain’t Misbehavin’, Blues in the Night, Billy Bishop goes to War and You’re A Good Man Charlie Brown, to name a few. He has performed twice as a piano soloist and many times as a vocalist with the Merced Symphony. In 1992 he was honored to conduct the Symphony in its annual children’s concert.

Dennis received his degree in piano performance from CSU Stanislaus and was employed by the university as a staff accompanist and vocal coach. He is presently studying voice with renowned mezzo-soprano, Sharon Graham. He has performed Handel’s Messiah as piano accompanist and baritone soloist several times in the central valley. Dennis is presently the Director of Music at St. Anne’s Parish in Lodi. He is honored to be working with John Leggett and Interfaith Community of Choirs.
